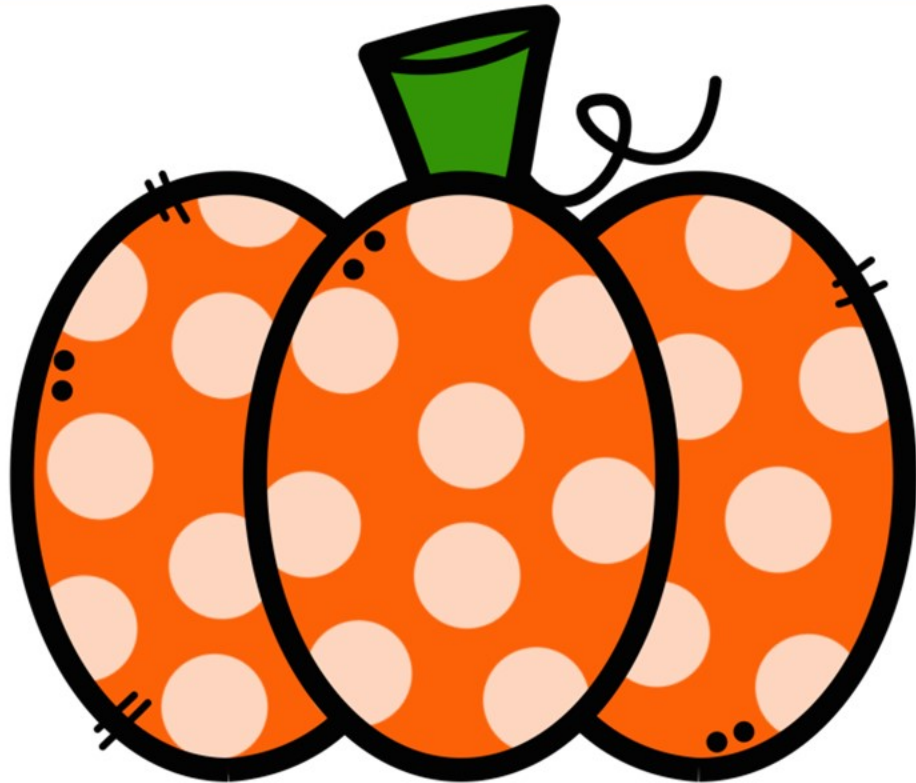

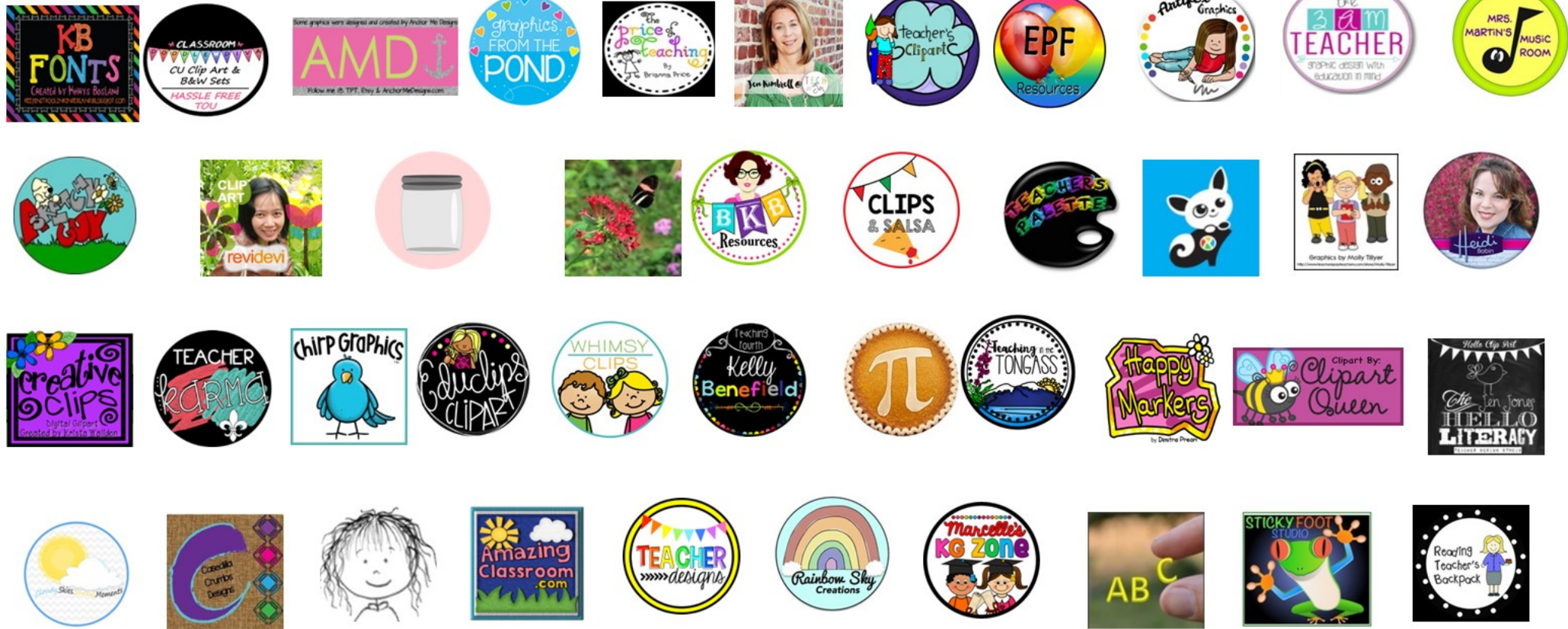

Resource Prep: Each activity below includes the prep needed to do activity with students in the description. It may include just copying worksheet or printing, laminating and cutting center games. Each direction to games are located on one of the game sheets for student use.

Resource Directions:

Pumpkin Literature List: Choose books from the list about leaf's to read to your students.

Pumpkin Writing Station Words: Print and laminate a few colored copies of the Pumpkin Writing Station words for students to use or copy one sheet for each student to put in their writing folder or journal.

Classroom Book: *All About Pumpkins* Classroom Book: After reading several books about pumpkins, copy cover on cardstock and then copy the student sheet for each student. Have them write and draw something that they know about the pumpkins. Collect each student paper and make classroom book binding or stapling book together.

Student Booklet: Pumpkin "I See" Student Booklet: Students can work on this booklet at center or quiet work time to practice their number and color words. Students copy over the number and color word and then color the pumpkins the correct color. You can copy the pages on regular paper, there are two booklet pages to each sheet with one cover and 10 other pages..

Student Worksheet: Retelling Graphic Organizer: After reading a story from the literature list a few times have students fill out the story retelling organizer, beginning, middle, and ending of the story.

Art Projects: The Pumpkin and Seeds Art Project: Copy and assemble the Pumpkin & Seeds with the directions and template page in unit. Hang the Pumpkins in the hallway or in the classroom for decorations.

Pumpkin Literacy Center: Pumpkin Roll It! Read It Short Vowel Sounds: Two types of game cards with short vowel sounds words and sentences. Each game card has all the vowel sound words and sentences on the game card. There are 4 game cards in total. Students roll one dice and read the words or sentences in the row they have rolled.

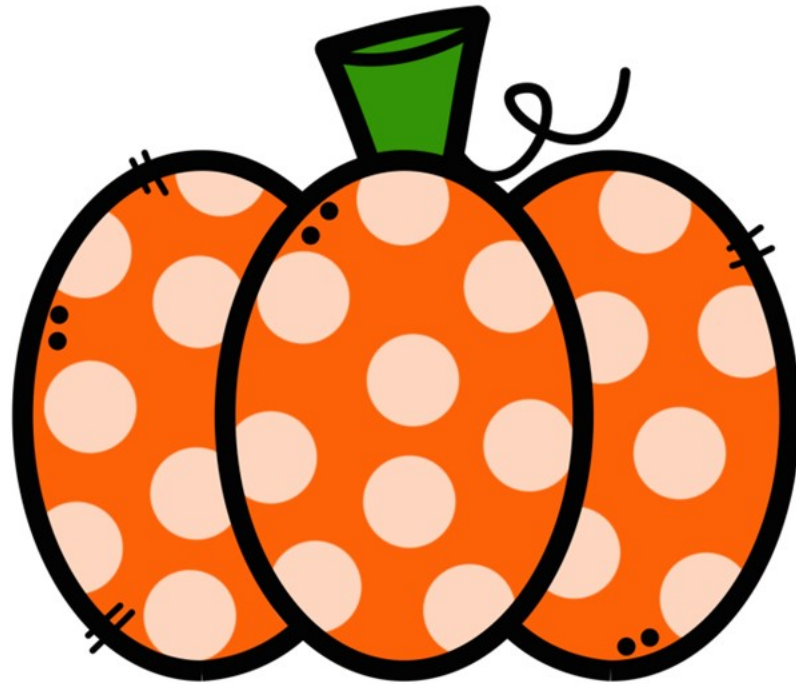
Retelling Story Organizer

Art Project

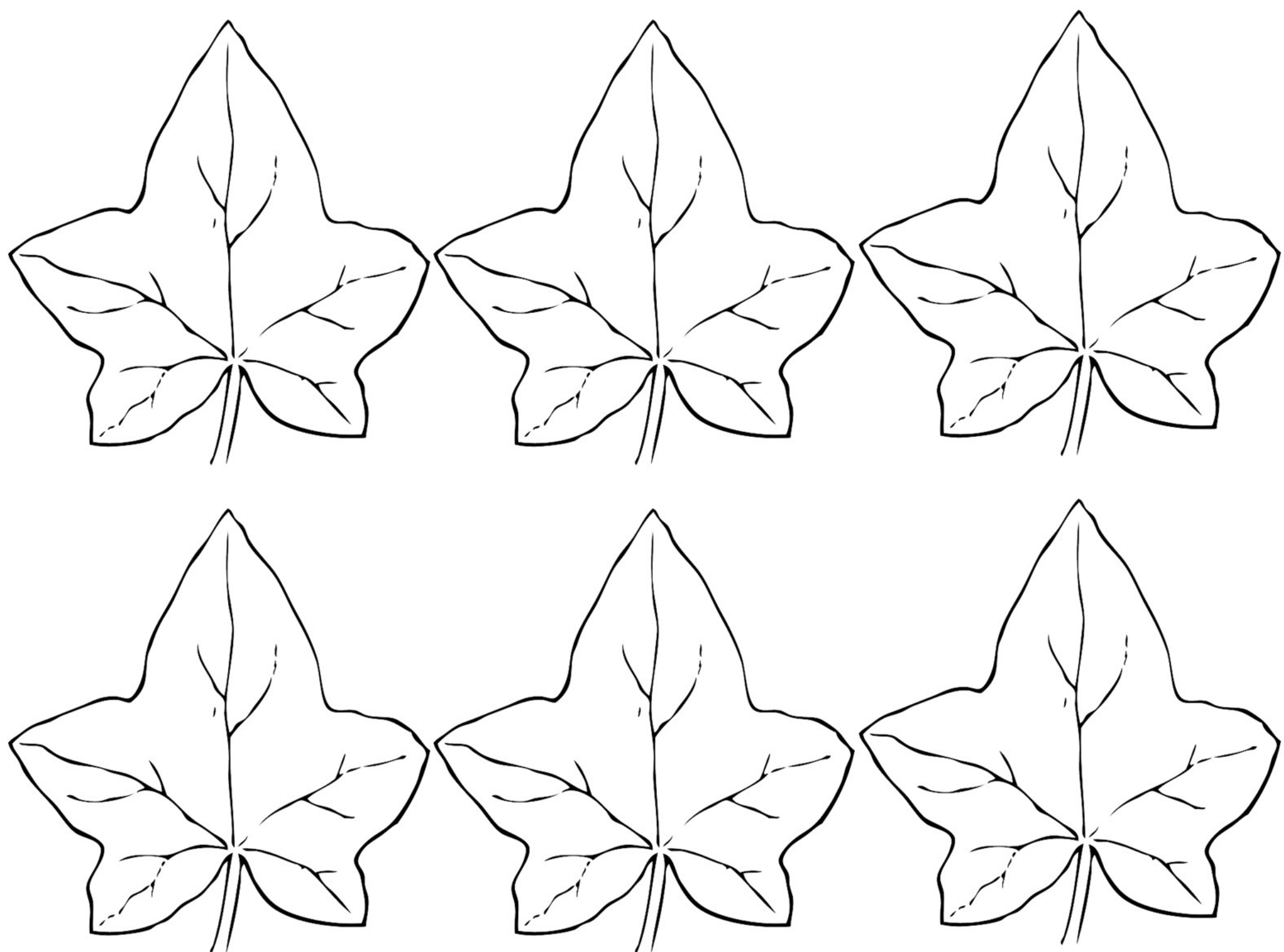


Pumpkin & Seeds Project

Materials Needed: Small white paper plate; brown construction paper (1 in. x 2 ½ in.); green pumpkin leaf (pattern in resource); 12 in. piece of orange yarn or twine; 6 pumpkin seeds; crayons; markers, or paint; scissors & glue.

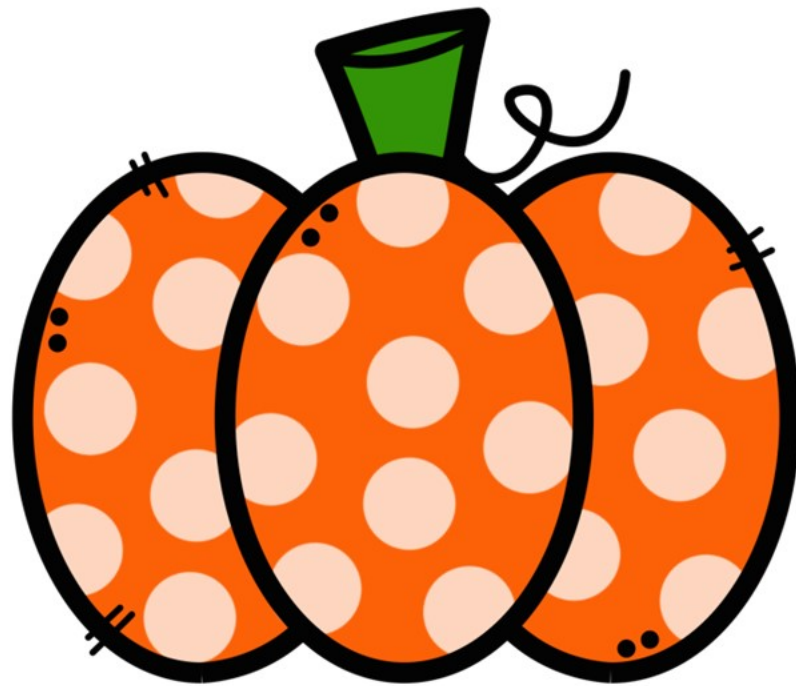
1. Flatten the small paper plates and have students either paint or color with marker or crayon it orange.
2. Have students attach the brown piece of construction paper on the top of the plate for the stem of the pumpkin.
3. On the paper plate have students make a squiggly line on glue and place the yarn or twine on top of the glue line. Have students glue the 6 pumpkin seeds around this yarn/twine line.
4. Have students cut out and attach the green leaf to the top of the pumpkin near the stem. Have students put their names on the back or on the front bottom of their pumpkins.
5. Hang the Pumpkins in the classroom or hallway for decorations.
