Turkey Mini Unit

Resource Prep: Each activity below includes the prep needed to do activity with students in the description. It may include just copying worksheet or printing, laminating and cutting center games. Each direction to games are located on one of the game sheets for student use.

Resource Directions:

Turkey Literature List: Choose books from the list about leafs to read to your students.

Turkey Writing Station Words: Print and laminate a few colored copies of the Pumpkin Writing Station words for students to use or copy one sheet for each student to put in their writing folder or journal.

Classroom Book: Our Turkey Disguises* Classroom Book: After reading the book "Turkey Trouble" copy cover on cardstock and then copy the student sheet for each student and have them write and draw what disguise they would dress up in if they were a turkey on Thanksgiving. Collect each student paper and make classroom book binding or stapling book together.


Student Booklet: "Turkeys" Student Booklet: Copy and assemble each of the "Turkeys" booklets for each students. There are two booklet pages to each sheet with one cover and 8 color pages. You can copy as many pages as you would like students to do. Students color the turkeys the correct color and then practice reading the booklet.


Student Worksheet: My Turkey Disguise Story: Use the templates provided and have students either write a story about how they would disguise their turkey, so it did not get eaten for Thanksgiving. After writing they can draw a picture of their turkey and its disguise in the space provided. This project can be done as a center, or with parent or buddy help with younger students.

Art Prajects: Turkey Art Praject Copy and assemble turkey using the directions and template page in unit. Hang turkeys in hallway or in the classroom for decorations.






This turkey is yellow.

Turkey Art Project

Materials Needed: Construction paper (brown, red, yellow, orange and various colors for feathers); brown body, white eyes, orange nose & feet & red snood templates; scissors, glue and pencil.

- I. Have the features of the turkey either cutout or have patterns for students to trace and cut out. Templates are on the next sheet in this unit.
- 2. Have students glue facial features on body of turkey and glue feet to the bottom of the body. Have students glue different colored feathers to the back of the body as shown in picture. You can decide how many feathers for each student. v
- 3. Students can write on each of the feathers what they are thankful for or you can leave the feathers plain.
